

2012 PA-TSA State Conference – April 18-21, 2012

Rates and Dates

Hotel Reservation - Paid to Seven Springs

Package A – 3 nights, all meals

- \$421.00 single occupancy
- \$317.00 double occupancy
- \$285.00 triple/quad occupancies

Package B – 2 nights (Wednesday, Thursday), all meals

- \$318.00 single occupancy
- \$227.00 double occupancy
- \$197.00 triple/quad occupancies

Package C – Individual Nights, includes breakfast

- \$145.00 single occupancy
- \$104.00 double occupancy
- \$95.00 triple/quad occupancies

TSA Registration – Paid to PA-TSA

- \$50 – Advisors, Students, Chaperones
- \$0 – Guests (not acting as chaperones or advisor; staying on-site)

Registration – Signature Events (VEX & F1)

- For TSA members already registered to compete at the State Conference in other TSA events, no additional registration fee.
- For non-TSA members and TSA members not otherwise registered for the State Conference, \$25 registration fee.

Cancellation Policy

- 14 days prior to conference – no fee
- Less than 14 days prior to conference - 1/3 reservation fee charged

Deadlines

Reservation Deadline – March 16, 2012

Event Registration Deadline – March 30, 2012

Late Event Registration Deadline – April 9, 2012

NOTES:

- Each school must include their school tax exempt number with their reservation or they will be charged tax on top of the reservation fee listed above
- The registration fee will be paid directly to PA-TSA, upon arrival to the conference on Wednesday.
- All projects must be registered/dropped off during the predetermined times. If this is not possible, you need to contact the Conference Director ahead of time to see if special arrangements can be made.
- Test sessions are not flexible. If a chapter/member is not present Wednesday night, they forfeit those testing sessions and will have to use the sessions on Thursday.
- If a chapter does not attend the Awards Ceremony and requests their trophies be sent to them after, the Chapter will be billed for the shipping costs. When possible, chapters should make arrangements to have neighboring chapters pick up their trophies for them.
