PURPOSE

To promote the growth and leadership of prospective technology education teachers.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

The amount of the scholarship will vary.

The scholarship is to be used for paying undergraduate tuition and fees at California University of Pennsylvania.

CRITERIA FOR AWARD SELECTION

The scholarship will be awarded to an incoming freshman majoring in technology education. Selection will be based on TSA activities, scholarship and financial need.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must have been active members of TSA in high school.
- The scholarship is for incoming freshmen to the undergraduate technology education program at California University of Pennsylvania.
- Applicants must submit the application and describe their TSA and scholastic achievements. Additional documentation may be submitted.
- A cover letter must describe the applicant's need for the financial award.
- Three letters of recommendation must be submitted, with one from a TSA Advisor.
- Applicants must be postmarked by June 1. Applicants are responsible to see that all materials are forwarded by the deadline. The application and recommendation letters may be submitted separately.
- Applications will be reviewed by a committee of three technology education professors. The top three candidates will be ranked, thus allowing for the awarding of the scholarship should any of the selected candidates be unable to accept. Recipients will be notified by June 15.
- Recipients will have twelve months to use the scholarship starting with the date of the notification. Scholarship money will be forwarded to the recipient in two installments. The first installment will be made during the recipient's first semester at California University of Pennsylvania, after the recipient submits proof of tuition and fees. The second installment will be made during the recipient's second semester, after the recipient submits proof of earning at least a 3.00 grade point average during the first semester.

FUNDING THE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship began with donations from TSA Club Advisors, Region 1 & 6 PA-TSA Coordinators, PA-TSA and supporters of TSA. An endowment account has been established and additional donations are being solicited to fund the scholarship.
